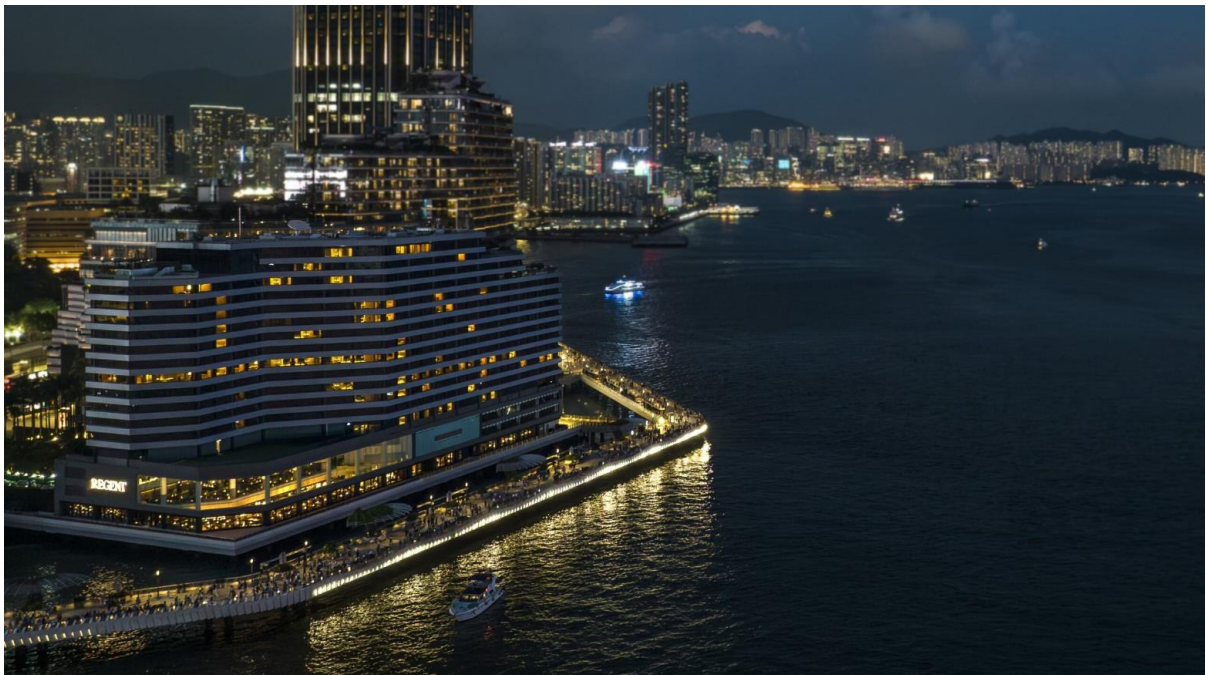

### Regent Hong Kong Awarded #3 of “The Top 10 Hotels in Hong Kong and Macau” in Condé Nast Traveler Readers’ Choice Awards 2024



2 October, 2024 (Hong Kong, SAR): Adding to an array of global accolades received this year, Regent Hong Kong has just been named #3 of [“The Top 10 Hotels in Hong Kong and Macau”](#) in the prestigious Condé Nast Traveler Readers’ Choice Awards 2024 (USA) and also one of the “Best Hotels in China” in the Condé Nast Traveler China Readers’ Choice Awards 2024. These distinctions follow a coveted spot on Condé Nast Traveler’s 2024 Hot List as one of the Best New Hotels earlier this year.
